PARTICIPATION EXPECTATIONS

In line with the Glenwood Code of Conduct and the commitments made by each learner on admission, every boy is required to participate in at least one sport or cultural activity per term. This is not optional. Compliance will be monitored through the ECA registration and attendance register process, and any failure to meet this expectation will be addressed directly with the learner and parent.

Sporting seasons may shift within a term, and learners may move between codes when seasonal transitions occur.

For example:

• In Term 3, a boy may complete Rugby and then move into Cricket.

This approach applies to all sporting and cultural codes. It is the responsibility of the learner and the parent to ensure these commitments are honoured. No excuses will be accepted. Guidance will be given at each transition, but ultimately, participation is compulsory.

Parents should contact the school only if there is genuine uncertainty; otherwise, it is expected that every boy meets the school's standards.











Expectations

- As above every learner is required to participate in an extra-mural activity each term and season. This is a non-negotiable expectation of the school.
- Extra-mural involvement is a cornerstone of discipline, fitness, belonging, and personal development, and every boy is expected to uphold these standards without exception.
- Training is compulsory. Learners must attend all scheduled practices, on time, and in the correct kit.
- Match attendance is compulsory. Selected players are expected to honour all fixtures unless formally excused.
- For any medical absence, a signed doctor's note is required.
- For non-medical absences, an email from a parent or guardian must be submitted to the Director of Sport, Sport Operations Coordinator, and the Grade Head at least 72 hours before the fixture for consideration.

Consequences:

- Glenwood will enforce the disciplinary measures for non-participation or failure to meet extramural commitments.
- Registers will be shared with parents and relevant staff once the full process is confirmed.

Homework Club is a structured academic space. It may not be used as a reason to avoid compulsory extra-mural commitments. We rely on parents and guardians to reinforce these expectations and ensure full participation.

Considerations for <u>Match Apparel</u>

- 1.1st teams are permitted to wear their 1st team apparel, provided that every player is dressed the same.
- 2. No crocs/flip flops are to be worn. Takkies/trainers must be worn with match apparel where necessary.
- 3. The short white socks must be predominantly white.
- 4. Hockey, soccer and rugby boots must be predominantly black.
- 5. Cricket shoes must be predominantly white.

Matches:

- 1. Learners must wear the official Glenwood match kit with black boots.
- 2. A full school tracksuit with takkies is required before and after matches.

Not permitted under any circumstances at practices, matches and PE:

- Crocs
- Socks-only
- Slippers

Physical Education (PE):

• The full Glenwood PE kit must be worn.

Practices (all sport)

- Learners must wear the official Glenwood practice kit with white socks.
- School tracksuits may be worn before and after practice, with takkies only.
- Permitted footwear:
- Proper sports takkies/sneakers.







BEHAVIOUR GUIDELINES:

The Glenwood sporting programme is guided by the values of Excellence, Integrity, Discipline, and Respect. All players, parents, supporters, and coaches are expected to uphold these standards at every training session, fixture, tour, or sporting event.

PLAYER EXPECTATIONS

All Glenwood sportsmen must:

- Display good sportsmanship at all times
- Respect referees, opponents, coaches, managers, and teammates
- Represent Glenwood with pride on and off the field
- Attend all practices and fixtures as scheduled
- · Arrive on time and correctly dressed
- Follow coaching instructions and team structures
- · Maintain personal discipline in effort, attitude, and behaviour
- Commit fully to their summer and winter sporting codes

PLAYER CONDUCT - NOT PERMITTED

Players may not:

- · Argue with or confront referees or officials
- Use rude, offensive, or disrespectful language
- Engage in sideline coaching or disrupt team structures
- Disrespect teammates, coaches, staff, or opponents
- Miss practices or fixtures without a valid and communicated reason
- Wear incorrect or informal clothing such as crocs, slops, slippers, or non-Glenwood uniform
- Display unsportsmanlike behaviour of any kind

SUPPORTER EXPECTATIONS

Parents and supporters are expected to:

- Support their sons and the team in a positive manner
- Encourage good sportsmanship at all times
- Respect officials, opponents, and coaching staff
- Allow coaches to coach without interference
- Model the Glenwood values in their conduct
- Place emphasis on teamwork, development, discipline, and effort not only results

SUPPORTER CONDUCT - NOT PERMITTED

Parents and supporters may not:

- Shout at, insult, or argue with match officials
- Engage in sideline coaching or contradict coaching instructions
- Confront referees, coaches, or opposition staff
- Display behaviour that reflects poorly on Glenwood or its image

With collective responsibility, discipline, and respect, Glenwood sport remains a proud and competitive environment for young men to grow and excel.

PARENTAL SUPPORT

At Glenwood, we expect parents to be a team behind the team. Your presence and support are not merely appreciated, they are part of the standard we uphold as a school. We strongly encourage every parent to attend fixtures, stand behind your son, his teammates, and the school he represents.

We also remind our community that many of our boys, especially boarders and those without active family support, compete each weekend without anyone on the sideline for them. This can be an isolating experience, particularly when results do not go their way. Glenwood parents are asked to stand behind all our boys, not only their own.

We take pride in making home fixtures a meaningful occasion. Our goal is to create an environment where parents are present, visible, and supportive right through to the 1st XV match. The boys notice it, and it matters.

Your commitment to showing up, supporting the team, and contributing to a united school atmosphere is an expectation of the Glenwood standard. Together, we ensure every boy feels backed by a strong, proud, and engaged school community.
