Grade 12 Departmental Paper.

Grade 11:

Two Papers:

Paper 1 to be written in class - Source-based, 2 Questions, Lenin's Economic Policies and Stalin's 5 Year Plans (50 Marks).

Paper 2 to be written during Control Test times - One essay on the Causes of the Great Depression (50 marks). Total 100 marks as per departmental grid.

Grade 10:

Source-based Question on the Spanish conquest of South America/Dutch in South Africa - 50 marks as per departmental grid.

Grade 9:

50 mark paper - Nazi Germany: Propaganda, the Holocaust and the beginnings of WW2 (pages 1-15 of the notes).

Grade 8:

50 mark paper - Industrial Revolution in Britain and South Africa - pages 1-17. Social issues of the Industrial Revolution, Trade Unions, South Africa in 1860 and the arrival of Indian Indentured labour and their lives.
